
CAMP RULES



CELL PHONES

- ◆ The decision of cell phone usage at camp is in the hands of the Dorm Leader.
- ◆ Throughout the week, some elements may allow students and adults to join in via social media (i.e., Twitter, Instagram, Facebook, etc.)
 However, these opportunities are optional and will not limit
 - the camp experience for those who do not participate.
- ◆ Unless instructed by staff, students with cell phones are not allowed to have them out or in use during programming elements: Small Groups, Worship, Night Life, Recreation and Elective Tracks. Ringers should be turned to silent or vibrate.

ACTIVITIES

- ◆ Participate in all activities and be on time.
- Drink plenty of water and eat three meals a day.
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes to recreation and ministry sites.
- Listen for directions from Recreational or Funtime Leader.
- Practice social distancing and use hand sanitizer or wash hands regularly throughout each activity.
- All campers are expected to attend all camp activities unless excused by the Head Cabin Leader.



HOUSING

- ◆ Be in your room by Lights out.
- No guys in girls' rooms or hallways and no girls in guys' rooms or hallways.
- Campers should not arrive at camp site before the published registration time on the opening day of camp
- ◆ No camper is allowed out of the dorms after lights out. Any camper who violates this rule will be sent home. There will be NO exceptions.

- ◆ No gum, food, or drinks allowed in the worship center.
- ◆ No video and flash photography are allowed in the worship center before or during the worship service.

DO NOT BRING


Make sure your students do NOT pack anything that:

- ◆ Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
- ◆ Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
- ◆ Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations.
- → Has spaghetti/small straps or open back, except for sleepwear.
- ◆ Alcohol, tobacco, ecigs/vaping devices, illegal drugs, and pornography are strictly prohibited. All medication brought to camp must be left with the camp medical personnel.
- ◆ No fireworks, lighters, firearms, knives, items capable of projecting laser light, or other weapons are allowed.

MEDICATIONS

◆ All medications will be checked in at the beginning of camp by the medical personnel. All prescriptions must come in its originally labeled container By law, prescription medications can only be administered as prescribed. During the week of camp, the medical personnel will be administering the medications and will return all medications the last day of camp. Medications will be released to the driver as the student is dismissed from camp.



- ◆ Due to covid temperatures checks will be taken at registration and periodically throughout the week.
- ◆ All medications shall be administered by the camp nurse only!

Acknowledgment of risk related to covid-19

Covid-19 policy

By entering onto any property of Texas Church of God or participating in any Texas Church of God programs or events, I, (on behalf of myself and my family members) acknowledge and agree with the following:

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization and is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is of course, ever-evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact



and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known cure for COVID-19.
